Conditions:

- 1. Operation of this equipment shall be conducted in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit is issued unless otherwise noted below.
- 2. This equipment shall be properly maintained and kept in good operating condition at all times.
- 3. Waste produced by the operation of this equipment shall only be discharged into containers which shall be maintained closed and sealed.
- 4. The HEPA filters used in negative air machines venting negative air enclosures shall be certified by the manufacturer to have a minimum control efficiency of 99.97 percent on 0.3 micron particles.
- 5. Whenever this equipment is used in conjunction with asbestos activities, the following conditions shall apply:
 - A. Use of this equipment requires prior written notification to the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) in accordance with Rule 1403.
 - B. Operation of this equipment shall be performed in compliance with all applicable requirements of the asbestos NESHAP (40CFR61 Subpart M).
 - C. When this equipment is used for removal of asbestos containing material, including, but not limited to, floor tiles and mastic, it shall only be operated within a negative air enclosure, and waste collected shall be disposed as friable asbestos waste.
 - D. After use, this equipment shall be cleaned within a negative air enclosure, and machine parts, and/or waste collected shall be disposed as friable asbestos waste.
 - E. All maintenance work on this equipment which requires partial or total dismantling shall be performed within a negative air enclosure.

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- F. A negative air enclosure used pursuant to condition 5C, 5D, and 5E shall only be used if it is vented to a negative air machine containing a HEPA filter which is in full use and which has been issued a permit to construct and/or operate by the Executive Officer of the South Coast AQMD.
- 6. Visible emissions shall not be discharged from any point on this equipment.
- Current contact person name, company, and phone number shall be displayed in a permanent and conspicuous location.
- 8. Upon the fifth day after placement of this equipment into operation at a new site, the South Coast AQMD shall be notified via telephone at 1-877-810-6995 of the exact nature of the project as follows:
 - A. The permit number of the portable equipment.
 - B. The name and phone number of a contact person.
 - C. The location where the portable equipment will be operated.
 - D. The estimated time the portable equipment will be located at the site.
 - E. Description of the project.
 - F. If less than ¼ mile, the distance to the nearest sensitive receptor, defined as: Long-term health care facilities, rehabilitation centers, convalescent centers, retirement homes, residences, schools, playgrounds, child care centers, and athletic facilities.
- 9. The following conditions shall apply to the use of this portable equipment:
 - A. This equipment shall not be operated, and shall not remain or reside, for more than twelve consecutive months at any facility within the South Coast AQMD.
 - B. The period during which the equipment is maintained at a designated storage facility shall be excluded from the residency time determination.
 - C. Any equipment that replaces the equipment at a site and is intended to perform the same function as the equipment being replaced shall be included in calculating the residency time period.
 - D. This equipment shall not remain or reside at a location for a period of less than 12 consecutive months where such a period represents the full length of normal annual source operations such as a seasonal source; or the equipment is removed from one location for a period and then it or its equivalent is returned to the same location thereby circumventing the portable equipment residence time requirements; or the equipment is moved at a site with no apparent operational reason other than to establish a new operational period.



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- E. For the purpose of this condition, a facility shall be defined as any source or group of sources or other air contaminant-emitting activities which are located on one or more contiguous properties within the district, in actual physical contact or separated solely by a public roadway or other public right-of-way, and are owned or operated by the same person (or by persons under common control).
- 10. A log concerning the operation of this equipment shall be kept and maintained for a period of five years. The last two years records shall be kept on site at the equipment operator's main office and shall be made available upon request of district personnel. This log shall contain the following information:
 - A. The information required by conditions 5A, 8, and 9.
 - B. The number of working hours per day involving lead removal and/or asbestos removal (whichever is applicable).
 - C. The South Coast AQMD permit numbers for all negative air machine(s) venting negative air enclosures used in conjunction with this operation.
- The initial location of the permitted equipment shall not be within 1,000 ft of a school.
- When used outside a negative air enclosure for non-asbestos work, the permitted equipment shall be used to treat a maximum of 33,334 square feet per calendar month.



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NOTICE

In accordance with Rule 206, this Permit to Operate or copy shall be posted on or within 8 meters of the equipment.

This permit does not authorize the emission of air contaminants in excess of those allowed by Division 26 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California or the applicable Rules and Regulations of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD). This permit cannot be considered as permission to violate existing laws, ordinances, regulations or statutes of other government agencies.
