Corrective Action

Sub contractors must perform and document a tailgate meeting at least once every 10 days. For consistency, it is recommended this is completed once per week.

	This grinder does not have its guard equipped.	An employee was immediately assigned to remove the grinder from use and equip its guard.
	An employee is exposed to flying particulates while working in close proximity to an employee using a chop saw to cut block.	The employee complied to obtain safety glasses.
	Overall impalement hazards are well protected, however, in the section picture rebar caps are missing.	Employees were immediately assigned to begin installing rebar caps.
	Scaffolding does not have the required planks, access ladder, and tag (green or red) installed.	Scaffolding must be fully planked. This means that any planks that fit between the supporting frames posts, must be installed. The maximum gap is 1" between planks, in less there is a supporting post. In that case, 9" is the maximum gap. An access ladder is also required. A red tag must be installed if a scaffold is out of service and a green tag must be installed when the scaffold is approved for use.



Employee is not maintaining sufficient water to control the dust while cutting block.

A continuous water supply is required to control dust while cutting block. The employee will ensure an additional employee helps with the task.
