Photo Comment Corrective Action



Employee was observed using an A-Frame ladder in a closed position.

The employee immediately complied to use his ladder in an open, locked, and level position. On a positive note, he was wearing the required PPE, including safety glasses.



Employees are working above their trigger height while inadequate railing is provided. The scaffold does not have the required guardrails installed and the top tie anchor is not secured within a 3:1 height to width ratio from the top of the scaffold.

Discussed with the foreman and the superintendent providing the required railing while the parapet wall is constructed. Railing will be installed shortly.



A trash chute was installed yesterday. Existing railing was removed, creating a fall hazard.

Discussed with the superintendent a method of installing railing for a few of these openings on a couple of levels.
