I asked a worker if he had the regulatory binder with him, and he said yes. However, when I asked to check the binder, he couldn't find it in the truck.

On the warehouse floor, there is an open pit approximately 4 feet deep without any caution tape to warn others of the hazard. Additionally, there is some angle iron hanging down that someone could potentially hit their head on.
