A site inspection was carried out on-site today and I was able to walk the site and look for any safety concerns. Finishes installation is ongoing.

Note the following good items that were observed:

- + Restrooms in place and stocked.
- + Hand washing stations are in place.
- + The sidewalk is well protected.

Note the following violation that needs attention:

Emergency Items:

- First aid kit missing. Ensure one is available on site to help with first aid related issues.
- Fire Extinguishers missing. NOTE: One or more fire extinguishers, rated not less than 2A, shall be provided on each floor. In multistory buildings, at least one fire extinguisher shall be located adjacent to stairway. A fire extinguisher, rated not less than 2A, shall be provided for each 3,000 square feet of the protected building area. Travel distance from any point of the protected area to the nearest fire extinguisher shall not exceed 75 feet.

PPE:

- Workers on site missing the necessary PPE. PPE is needed to protect them from common construction hazards on the site.

Housekeeping:

- A sizable amount of debris, drywall and excess materials are building up in the garage. This is a trip hazard. Consider using the "clean as you go" method for clean up.

Stairways:

- Toe-boards missing from the top of the stairway. Toe-boards protect tools and materials from potentially falling below and striking someone. A standard toe-board shall be 4 inches (nominal) minimum in vertical height from its top edge to the level of the floor, platform, runway, or ramp. It shall be securely fastened in place and have not more than 1/4-inch clearance above floor level.
- Mid-rail missing on second floor. Ensure a mid-rail or equivalent is in place to avoid fall hazards. The mid-rail should be midway between the floor and top rail and have the ability to support 150 lbs of force. Sub-contractors ensure the stairway is left in a safe condition.

Other:

- Doors are leaned up against the wall at several locations. They are not secured. This is a falling object hazard.

Consider securing them or blocking off the area where they are being stored.

Overall, the site was found in satisfactory condition.
