Note the following good items that were observed:

- + Site is clean and organized.

- + First aid kit on site.
- + Eye wash station on site.

Note the following violations that needs to be addressed:

Impalement Hazards:

- Grounding stakes for the temp electrical panel pose an impalement hazard.

Note: Cal Osha mentions the following: "Protection from Reinforcing Steel and Other Similar Projections. (1) Employees working at grade or at the same surface as exposed protruding reinforcing steel or other similar projections, shall be protected against the hazard of impalement by guarding all exposed ends that extend up to 6 feet above grade or other work surface, with protective covers, or troughs.

Postings:

- Labor law posters are from 2022. 2024 labor laws need to be posted.

Electrical:

- Temp panel cover has fallen to the ground. Replace it as soon as possible. This is a shock hazard for anyone using the temp power pole.

Stairways:

- Toe-boards missing from the top of the stairway. Toe-boards protect tools and materials from potentially falling below and striking someone. A standard toeboard shall be 4 inches (nominal) minimum in vertical height from its top edge to the level of the floor, platform, runway, or ramp. It shall be securely fastened in place and have not more than 1/4-inch clearance above floor level.

Overall, the site was found in satisfactory condition.
