Impalement Hazards:

- Metal stake on site poses an impalement hazard.

Note: Cal Osha mentions the following: "Protection from Reinforcing Steel and Other Similar Projections. (1) Employees working at grade or at the same surface as exposed protruding reinforcing steel or other similar projections, shall be protected against the hazard of impalement by guarding all exposed ends that extend up to 6 feet above grade or other work surface, with protective covers, or troughs.

Trench:

- A trench on site deeper than 5 feet is missing proper protection. Covers shall be designed by a qualified person and be capable of safely supporting the greater of 400 pounds or twice the weight of the employees, equipment and materials that may be imposed on any one square foot area of the cover at any time. Covers shall be secured in place to prevent accidental removal or displacement, and shall bear a pressure sensitized, painted, or stenciled sign with legible letters not less than one inch high, stating: "Opening -Do Not Remove." Markings of chalk or keel shall not be used.
