A site inspection was carried out on-site today and I was able to walk the site and look for any safety concerns. The project is progressing well with interior work such as drywall being installed on the upper buildings and framing is almost done on the lower building of the site.

Note the following good items that were observed:

- + Fire extinguishers and first aid kit are on site.
- + Bathroom, washing facilities and trash cans are in place.
- + Safe use of heavy equipment observed.
- + Good capping of impalement hazards observed.
- + Power tools with guards in place observed.
- + Good use of PPE observed around site.
- + Ladders were observed on site with safety labels.

Note the following violations that need to be addressed:

Fall Protection:

- 2 roofers were connected to one anchor point. These anchor points are typically only rated for one worker. A reminder was given on site and this was corrected.

Guardrails:

- A mid-rail was missing at a chase in building a on the first floor. Note: The site contact is following with caring for this.

Ladder:

- Ladder leading to the roof of building D needs an offset wall or a gate so that workers cannot fall down the opening where the ladder is located.

Overall, the site was found in satisfactory condition. The team is to be commended for their hard work and attention to safety.
