I met with Joel at the construction site, where he confirmed that he is conducting the daily safety inspections using the SCC app, as well as the weekly tailgate training. The safety program and permit binders are stored in the construction office, and the federal and state posters are properly displayed.

During my walk-through of the site, I observed several safety issues: on lot 1035, a scaffold on the third level was missing a plank; on lot 1039, the scaffolding had planks that were not properly overlapped, leaving a significant gap; and on lot 1038, an open trench was found with the danger tape knocked down. All three issues were corrected on-site.

There is water available on site, and the trades also bring their own. Structural shade is available throughout the site. The site is well-maintained, with good housekeeping practices and clean restrooms.
